### **About KMIDS**

At KMIDS, our students become Masters of Innovation, full of inspiration and imagination. Their experience here allows them to become thoroughly educated in all aspects of 21<sup>st</sup> Century skills, developing them as fully qualified candidates for admission to KMITL and other leading universities in Thailand and abroad.

By surpassing the highest level of Thai and International education standards, KMIDS graduates will have a higher success rate in their pursuit of higher education in Thailand and abroad, ultimately serving as the key economic and social development forces for Thailand's future.

### **Scholarships**

As academic excellence is the primary feature of KMIDS study, the school offers scholarships to students who have demonstrated outstanding achievement in their previous academic performance and who have the potential to make significant contributions to the enrichment of KMIDS and, ultimately, to King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang.

KMIDS offers up to **EIGHT scholarships** to outstanding applicants who are inquisitive thinkers with a thirst for knowledge. These selected individuals are expected to be leaders among their peers, inspiring others in the student community to achieve the same level of academic excellence. Up to five scholarships are offered to middle school students and up to three scholarships are offered to high school students. Each successful candidate who meets the eligibility criteria and passes the scholarship selection process will be presented with a monetary scholarship amount which is deductible from tuition costs. Scholarships are generally awarded in the first quarter of the school year of each year.

**All scholarship applicants are required to complete the normal KMIDS admission process, and admission fees must be paid prior to submitting scholarship applications. Students who are recipients of KMIDS academic scholarships are not eligible to also apply for special talent scholarships. Decisions made by the school's management team on scholarship awards is final.**

### **Scholarship Tiers**

KMIDS offers three tiers of scholarships in recognition of the outstanding efforts of students who qualify within each level:

<b>Middle School (Five Scholarships)</b>
Two KMITL Chancellor's Scholarships 184,000 baht
Two KMITL President's Scholarships 138,000 baht
One KMIDS Director's Scholarship 92,000 baht

<b>High School (Three Scholarships)</b>
One KMITL Chancellor's Scholarship 192,000 baht
One KMITL President's Scholarship 144,000 baht
One KMIDS Director's Scholarship 96,000 baht

Students that wish to apply must:

- Hold a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.80 or above from their current school
- Hold a bronze, silver or gold medal in the field of science, math or technology\*
- Demonstrate strong English proficiency by performing well in one of the English proficiency tests administered in the application process

\*Students must provide evidence of their gold, silver or bronze award at KMIDS.

### **Document Submission**

Applicants who are eligible to apply for scholarships must write their intention to the KMIDS admission staff and also enclose the following documents:

- A copy of the student's national ID card or passport
- A copy of the household registration (Thai citizen only)
- Official transcripts which show the student's cumulative GPA:

### **Middle School**

#### Grade Six

Transcripts of prathom four and five or equivalent from an overseas or international school

- A student portfolio highlighting student strengths and community service
- Gold, silver or bronze medal from an academic competition
- Two letters of recommendation from teachers at their current school (Using forms provided by KMIDS)

- Statement of purpose outlining how the student can contribute to KMIDS (Including details of any previous achievement in school or through external organizations).

#### Grade Seven

Transcripts of prathom four-five and prathom six (First semester) or equivalent from an overseas or international school

- A student portfolio highlighting student strengths and community service
- Gold, silver or bronze medal from an academic competition
- Two letters of recommendation from teachers at their current school (Using forms provided by KMIDS)
- Statement of purpose outlining how the student can contribute to KMIDS (Including details of any previous achievement in school or through external organizations).

#### Grade Eight

Transcripts of prathom five-six and matthayom one (First semester) or equivalent from an overseas or international school

- A student portfolio highlighting student strengths and community service
- Gold, silver or bronze medal from an academic competition
- Two letters of recommendation from teachers at their current school (Using forms provided by KMIDS)
- Statement of purpose outlining how the student can contribute to KMIDS (Including details of any previous achievement in school or through external organizations).

### **High School**

#### Grade Nine

Transcripts of prathom six, matthayom one and matthayom two (First semester) or equivalent from an overseas or international school

- A student portfolio highlighting student strengths and community service
- Gold, silver or bronze medal from an academic competition
- Two letters of recommendation from teachers at their current school (Using forms provided by KMIDS)
- Statement of purpose outlining how the student can contribute to KMIDS (Including details of any previous achievement in school or through external organizations).

#### Grade Ten

Transcripts of matthayom one-two and matthayom three (First semester) or equivalent from an overseas or international school

- A student portfolio highlighting student strengths and community service
- Gold, silver or bronze medal from an academic competition
- Two letters of recommendation from teachers at their current school (Using forms provided by KMIDS)
- Statement of purpose outlining how the student can contribute to KMIDS (Including details of any previous achievement in school or through external organizations).

The above documentation must be submitted by **Fri, 9 October 2020 (noon)**

The assessment process will take place at KMIDS on **Sun, 18 October 2020** and will include the following:
